Objective

To create bilateral awareness between the IJCC and businesses in regional areas in Japan. The primary goal is to assist in fostering existing connections as well as to create new partnerships between Ireland and Japan through the activities in relation with regional areas in Japan that we plan & attempt & accomplish.

What we do

- Fostering existing connections
Reach out to companies and local governments in regional areas that have an existing connection with Ireland but may not be aware of the business and networking opportunities that the IJCC can further provide.
- Creating new connections
Reach out to business organisations such as rotary clubs, coop groups and local chambers of commerce, in order to have information about the IJCC distributed internally within each respective organisation to a wider variety of companies in regional areas and create business connections and outreach towards the IJCC.
- Collaborating actively with members being based in regional areas
Hold online events to provide members based in regional areas chances of promoting businesses in their regions and networking with other chamber members to tighten connections of Ireland-Japan business beyond physical distances.
- Sharing Event information
Share between the IJCC and regional areas information on both in-person and online events that present business opportunities.
- Promoting the mentorship program
Promote the IJCC mentorship program to Japanese students, JET participants etc. in regional areas who are interested in studying or working in Ireland.
